YARD WASTE COMPOST

Yard waste consists mainly of grass clippings, leaves, and small tree limbs. These items belong in the bin with the LIGHT GREEN lid.

Accepted Materials

- Leaves
- Grass clippings
- Tree limbs (<6' in length & <24" in diameter)
- Hay and/or straw
- Cull fruit
- Stall bedding and manure

Prohibited Items

- Construction debris/wood
- Sod and root balls
- Dirt and rocks

Plastic bags

No animal/pet waste

Food waste is NOT accepted in the curbside collection at this time - there is a free food waste drop off inside the City Municipal Campus located at 333 West Ave.

SERVICE AND TRANSPARENCY



GUIDELINES

CONTAINERS

Containers are plastic, steel, and aluminum bottles, cans, and containers. They belong in the bin with the **BLUE** lid. Please remove and discard plastic caps. Rinse & drain food containers.

Completely drain non-food containers.

Accepted Items

- #1, #2, #5 plastic bottles, jugs, and jars
- #5 tubs and to-go containers
- Clear #1 blister/clamshell containers and clear #1 cups
- Steel cans
- Aerosol cans
- Popcorn/cookie tins
- Beverage cans
- Pet food cans
- Ball aluminum cups

Prohibited Items in container

- Plastics #3, #4, #6, #7
- Any colored clamshell/blister containers
- Plastic bags (#2 and #4 bags and film is recyclable at local grocery stores)
- Foam/Styrofoam of any kind
- Glass
- Aluminum foil, pie tins
- Scrap metal
- Electronics/E-waste
- Batteries of any kind
- Hazardous materials: asbestos, chemicals oils, paints, cleaners, needles, etc.
- Medical waste: used gloves/masks, medicine
- Motor oil containers

Glass will not be collected on curbside routes. Glass can be recycled at the drop-off. City-wide drop sites may be announced in the future.

FIBERS

Fibers include paper, cardboard, and chipboard and belong in the bin with the **VELLOW** lid.
Cardboard may need to be folded, cut, or ripped to fit into the bin.

Accepted Items

Paper

- Newspapers
- Office paper
- Magazines
- Paperback books
- Egg cartons
- Phone books (with plastic and magnets removed)
- Shredded paper

Cardboard/Chipboard

- Clean, unwaxed corrugated cardboard boxes
- Brown paper bags
- Cereal/cracker boxes
- Soda/beer boxes
- Toilet paper/paper towel tubes

Prohibited Items in container

- Greasy pizza boxes/food-stained materials
- Tissues and paper towels
- Aseptic cartons such as waxy juice/milk cartons and cups
- Plastic newspaper sleeves
- Yard debris/food waste
- Construction debris/wood
- Plastic or glass containers

RECYCLING PROCEDURE

If your collection occurs in the alley, containers should be placed on the same side of the alley as the trash cans. Containers must be out by **7 AM** on pickup day. Assistance for seniors and those with physical limitations is also available.
